When my brother Raad Stepho has been hurt in a terrible work related accident, he suffered 18 fractures. All his limbs were in cast and he needed 27/7 care and attention. I went to numerous places in an effort to find the proper facility that would provide adequate care, but I couldn't find any place that was suitable for him. Finally, through someone's recommendation I found Cambridge Manor in Alpharetta. During my first visit at Cambridge Manor, I met the staff and felt comfortable with their knowledge and experience in the care-giving field.
